



ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Perth Temporary Fencing (PTF) is committed to the responsible management of the natural environment. PTF's approach to Environmental Management is one of continuous improvement. This is achieved at all levels of the organization through:

The management of PTF recognises its responsibility to meet the requirements of this policy and its objectives. Our objectives in implementing our policy are:

- To apply and to require our contractors to apply the risk management principle of "as little as reasonable practicable" (ALARP) to environmental issues;
- To establish environmental management standards that meet or surpass statutory, industry and, where applicable, client requirements;
- To continually review and where appropriate to amend our environmental standards to reflect developments in technology, statutory requirements, industry practice and community standards;
- To develop and implement contingency plans for the control and correction of all environmental incidents that could be reasonably foreseen;
- To inform all PTF personnel and contractors of their responsibilities in relation to environmental matters and to monitor the manner in which their responsibilities are discharged; and
- To regularly audit our business activities to ensure that the objective stated above are being met.
